Time for Silver Beaver Nominations

The Silver Beaver Award is presented by the National Council, Boy Scouts of America, through the Voyageurs Area Council to adult volunteer Scouters for their distinguished service to youth and their community. The award is intended to acknowledge noteworthy service of exceptional character to youth by registered Cub Scouters, Scouters, Varsity Scouters and Venturing leaders within the territory under the jurisdiction of the local Council.

Any currently registered adult Scouter (21 or older) within the Voyageurs Area Council who has a record of quality service to Scouting, his or her community, and non-scouting youth, is eligible for nomination.

The nature and value of noteworthy service of exceptional character could consist of a single significant action with extraordinary results, a plan of various activities contributing to the lives of a large number of youths, or it may be results generated over an extended time with a relatively small group. There are no prerequisites such as District Award of Merit or Wood Badge.
